An award winning actor and singer with a passion for human rights and social justice, Jackie Richardson has been performing world-wide for over 5 decades. Canada's foremost singer of gospel, blues and jazz, Jackie was honoured in 2004 with a Maple Blues Award for lifetime achievement from the Toronto Blues Society. Acting accolades followed with a Dora, a Gemini, and in 2007, a lifetime achievement award from Canadian Actor's Equity.

The Stephen Lewis Foundation, the Children's Aid Foundation, the Nelson Mandela Children's Fund, and the Red Cross Haiti Earthquake Appeal fund are amongst the charities for which Jackie has chosen to perform.

Jackie performed at CRC's 40 Oaks Opening Celebration in April 2012 and at CRC's Building Lives Benefit in October 2014. We are honoured to once again have her support for CRC's 2016 Building Lives Benefit and the Regent Park neighbourhood.
